Mediation in Singapore: The Evolution of ADR in Singapore

It has been almost twenty years since the modern mediation movement began in Singapore. Over the last two decades, there have been many developments that have led to the growth and evolution of ADR in Singapore. This lecture will track the birth of the mediation movement and the process of its growing up. It will also look at the various developments in Singapore, some more recent than others, that have led mediation to become more accepted by users and the legal community.

The mediation movement has also expanded its reach beyond Singapore by becoming a thought leader in mediation and by forging friendships with various institutions in the region. The lecture will also explore these innovations and relationships and will also make some predictions about the future of the mediation movement in Singapore.
